Introduction to MUC

Located in Beijing, the capital of China, Minzu University of China is a new-type institution of higher learning established by the Chinese government to address ethnic issues in China and train ethnic leaders and various qualified professionals. It is a national key university jointly sponsored by the National Ethnic Affairs Commission of China, the Ministry of Education and the Beijing Municipal People's Government. As the top institution of higher ethnic education in China, it plays an irreplaceable role in the higher education system of the country and boasts extensive influence among ethnic minority groups and in ethnic regions. Since its establishment, its development has been prioritized by the state.

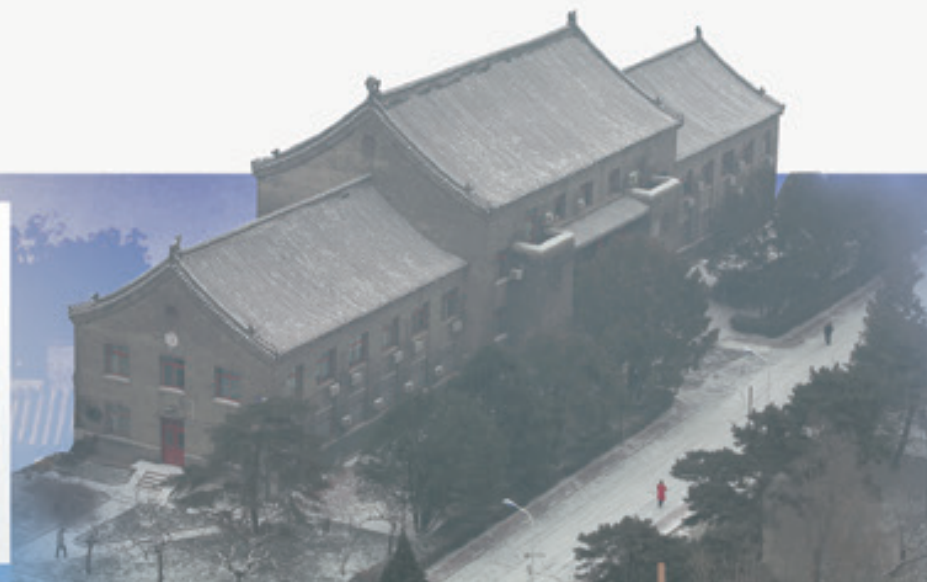

In **1951**, Central Minzu Institute was officially opened in Beijing.



In **1979**, Central Minzu Institute was included in the list of "National Key Universities" by the Ministry of Education.



In **1993**, Central Minzu Institute was renamed Minzu University of China.



In **1999**, MUC became one of the "Project 211" universities (a project of national key universities and colleges, covering the 112 best universities in China).



In **2002**, the State Ethnic Affairs Commission, the Ministry of Education, and the Beijing Municipal People's Government signed the *Agreement on Building Minzu University of China*.



In **2004**, MUC became one of the "Project 985" universities (a project of national key colleges and universities, covering the 39 best universities in China).



In **2017**, MUC became one of the universities under "Double First-Class" Project established by the state government in 2017 (a project of national key colleges and universities, covering the 36 best universities in China).

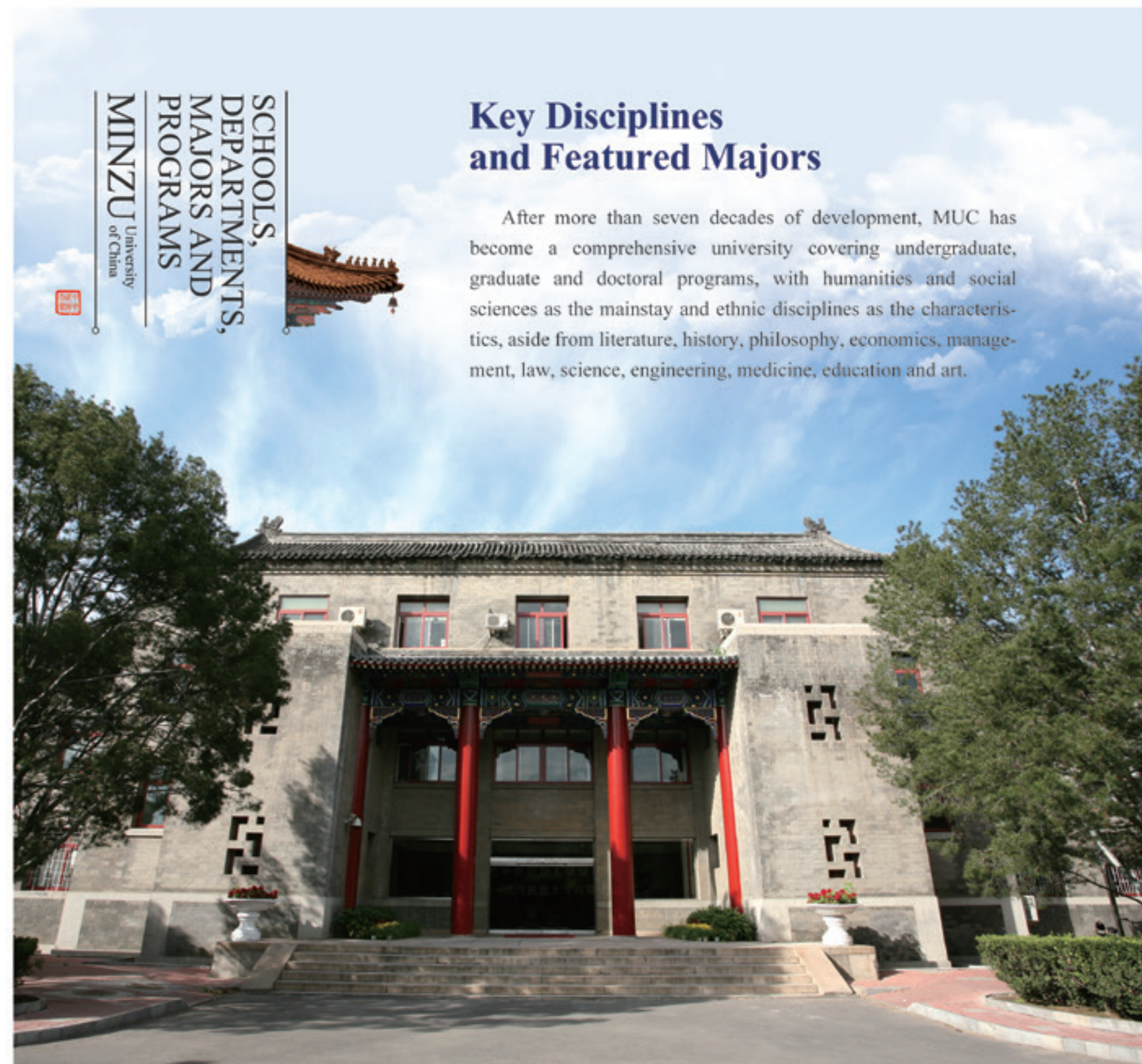

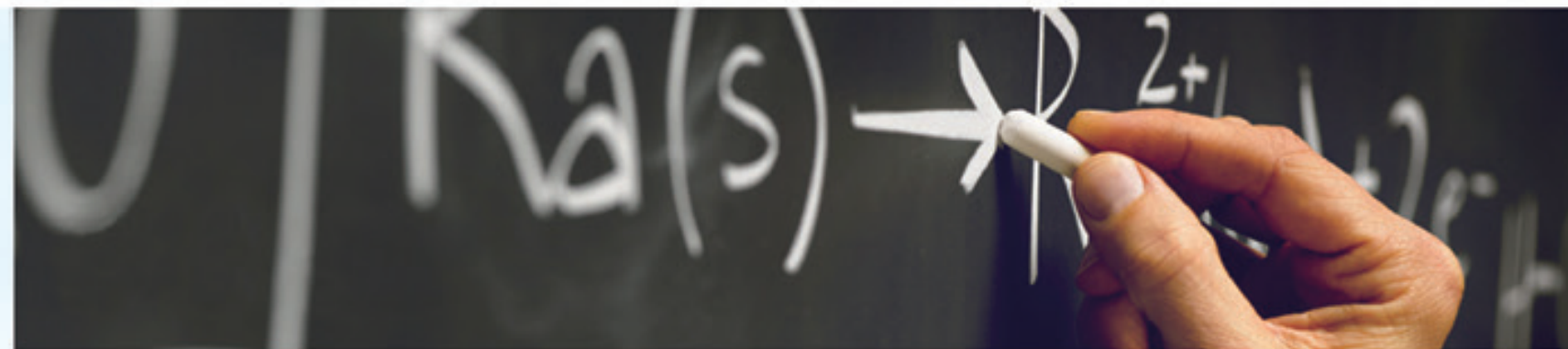
MUC has received more than **100**

MUC is an important base of ethnic studies in China, with fruitful findings in its scientific research.

In the first years of MUC's establishment, teachers and students participated in the identification researches of ethnic groups, determining the pattern of the 55 ethnic minorities in China and laying the foundation for China to implement ethnic regional autonomy. Based on researches, they clarified the history and social status of ethnic minorities, furnishing an important basis for the social reform of ethnic regions. They were involved in studies of ethnic minorities' languages, making possible a comprehensive understanding of their status and helping 16 ethnic groups create and reform their written languages.

In recent years, important research achievements of MUC, including the "Theory of a Pluralistic Unity of the Chinese Nation," the proposal for accelerating the development of the western region to narrow the gap between the east and the west, the new archaeological discovery of Xisha and Nansha, have played positive roles in facilitating the macro decision-making of the central government, the development of the Chinese humanities and social sciences, the prosperity and progress of the ethnic regions, and the maintenance of national unity and state unification. Many have become winners of awards by provincial- and ministerial-level institutions.

Adhering to the integration of Chinese realities with disciplinary progress, MUC has made a host of research achievements with significant academic values and social practice, in such fields as the development of ethnic minorities, cross-border ethnic groups and frontier stability, relevance of ethnic and religious issues to national security, circumstances of the Chinese languages, protection of species and the environment for ethnic regions.

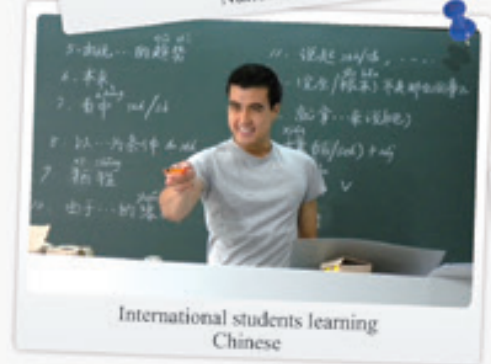

MUC is one of the first eight Chinese universities to enroll overseas students and conduct teaching and research in Chinese as a foreign language. It is one of the famous Chinese universities in teaching Chinese as a foreign language and among the first demonstration bases for international students in China. 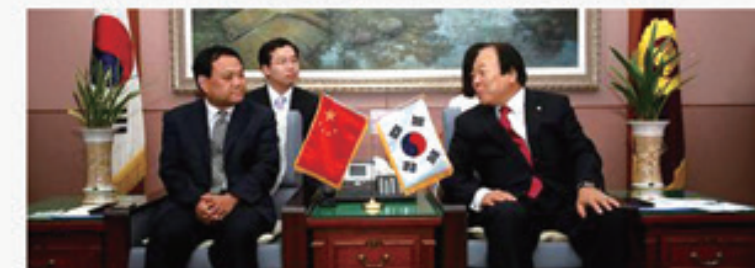

Learning Resources

• Library

The Library, covering an area of 25,000 square meters, has a collection of 4.57 million volumes, including more than 180,000 volumes in 20 ethnic minority languages.

The Library, designated as the “National Key Organization Under Protection for Ancient Books”, has a collection of more than 250,000 thread-bound ancient volumes and more than 3,200 ancient local chronicles, accounting for one-third of the total number of such ancient local chronicles in China. Its collection includes good edition books in more than 30,000 volumes, including 16 books included in the National Catalogue of Precious Ancient Books.

In addition, the University is close to National Library of China, the largest in Asia, which helps facilitate research and academic studies for both teachers and students.

• Museum

The Museum of Ethnic Cultures, a museum for ethnological studies, mainly collects, displays and researches cultural objects of China's 56 ethnic groups. With a total area of more than 4,800 square meters, the Museum has a collection of 14 categories of more than 20,000 production tools, daily necessities, religious objects, clothes, ancient artifacts, literatures, musical instruments, and others from China's various ethnic groups. The collection includes prehistoric painted pottery jars, bronze drums from the Eastern Han Dynasty (25 - 220), and Buddha statues, Thangka, zutu, tianlutu, palm-leaf manuscripts, and Dongba manuscripts from the Ming (960-1127) and Qing (1636-1912) Dynasties.

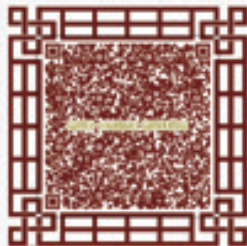

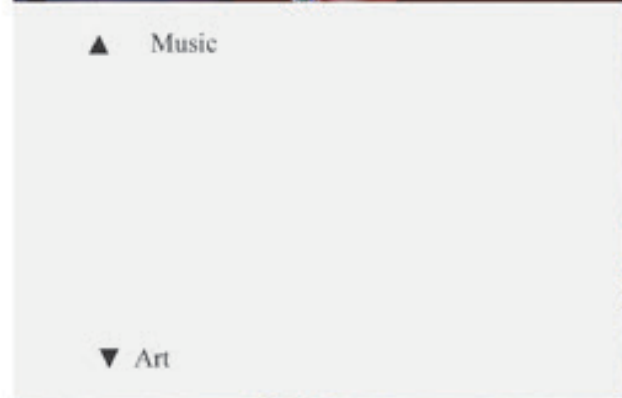
